MORE THAN A MAKEOVER

ATRUE COLLABORATION!

This Queer Eye LEGO® set was the result of a true Fab Five-style collaboration between the LEGO design team and the show's own design guru, Bobby Berk. For Bobby it quickly became a passion project: "LEGO played such an important part in my childhood. Clicking those little bricks together really sparked my imagination and creativity." Matthew Ashton, LEGO Vice President of Design, saw the collaboration as the perfect partnership: "We share so many values, like caring, learning, creativity and fun. While the Fab Five rebuild people's lives, we are on a mission to inspire kids and adults to get creative and be part of rebuilding a more positive world."

The first task was to decide exactly what the set should be. The team quickly zeroed in on the original loft setting from the first season and together defined the model's floor plan and layout. For Matthew it was vital they captured as many details as possible: "We wanted to replicate the furniture and include iconic details like the STYLE, TASTE, CLASS' sign. We also wanted to include a distinct zone for each of the guys and play up to each of the Fab Five's unique skills and contributions to the team."






CLICKING IT ALL TOGETHER

Just like it is for the Fab Five, teamwork is an essential part of developing a great LEGO® set. The other members of Matthew's LEGO Dream team were Senior Graphic Designer, Diego Sancho and Senior Element Designer, Ruth Kelly. Diego had the important task of capturing the Fab 5's likeness in LEGO minifigure form, as well as designing all the decorations and stickers to bring the loft to life: "I got the opportunity to do my personal take on the artwork for the loft, to add some nice Easter Eggs for the fans! I created a 'Yaaas Queen' print for the kitchen to celebrate the fun LGBTQ+ saying, and if you look closely at the unique brush-stroke art you will see it says FAB 5!"

For Ruth the challenge was very different: "We simply didn't have any existing wigs with a coif quite as voluminous as Tan's, so it was my job to sculpt a new one. We decided to mould the wig in shimmering silver plastic to really 'elevate' Tan's look!"


